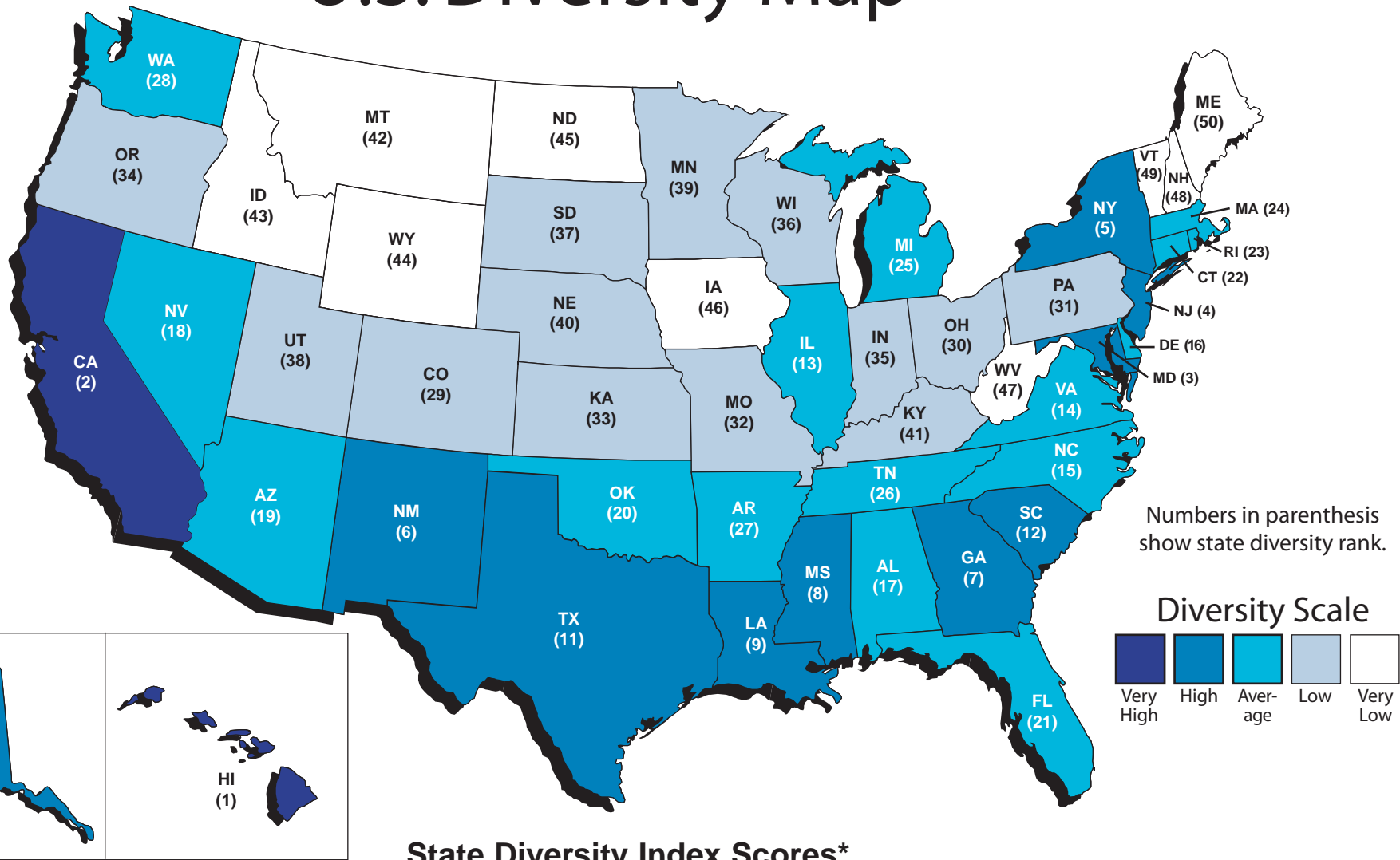


# U.S. Diversity Map

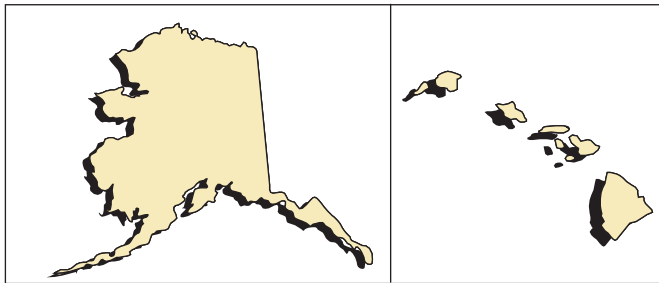
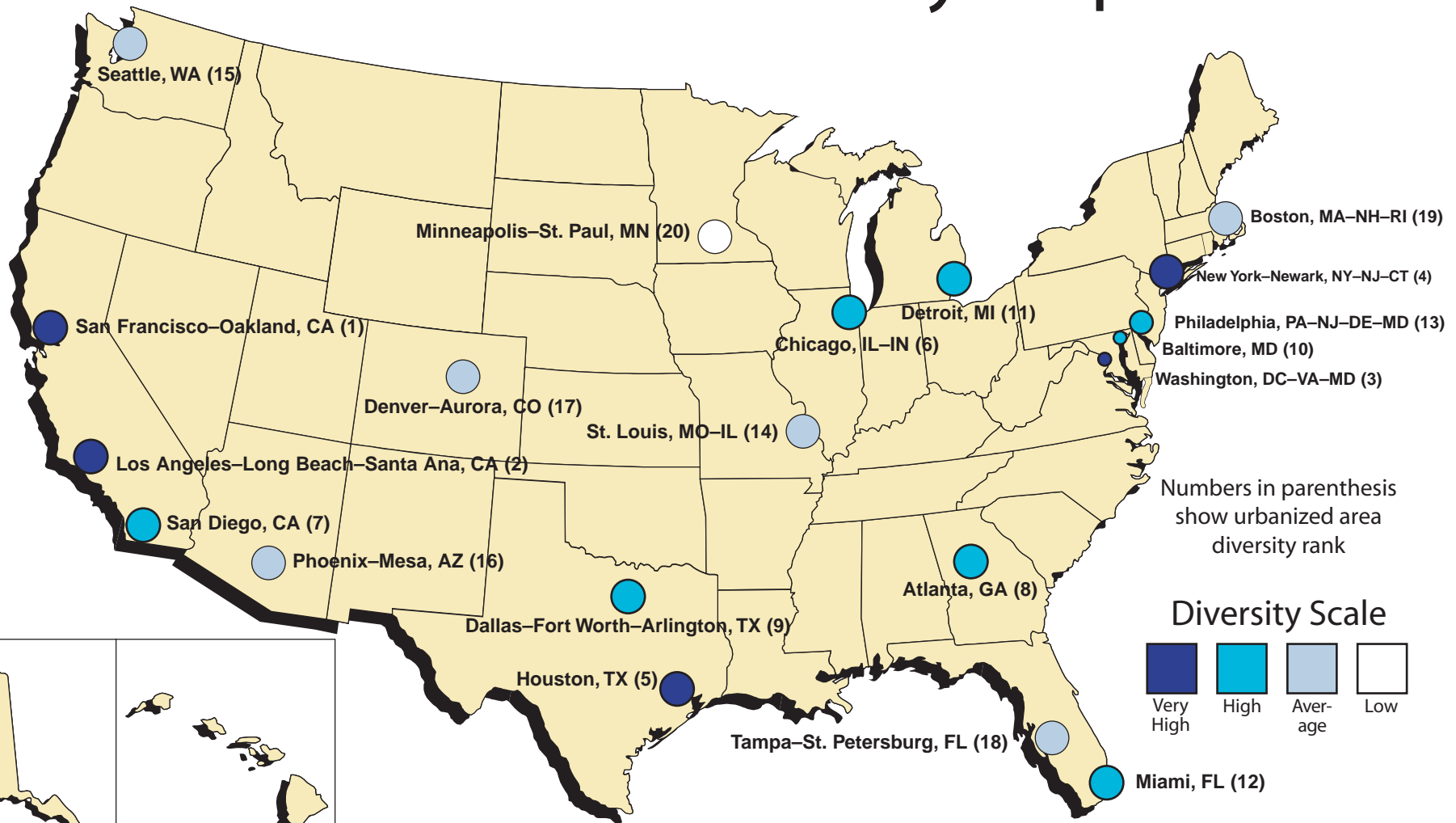
